In his First Letter to the Corinthians, Saint Paul wrote, "For just as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of the body, though many, are one body, so it is with Christ."

Without any one member, a body is incomplete and cannot function at its full capacity. But, when all parts are working together, then the person can perform as God intended. Such is

the case with the ministries of our community. When all of our stewards participate, we thrive.

In our discussions on Stewardship this fall we spoke about what it means to participate fully in giving. We are directed to offer our time, talent, and treasure to God. We know from the Old Testament that when we bring the fullness of our offering, God will bless and give it back to us in abundance. God is so serious about this that He even invites us to test Him in this one aspect of our lives! Please prayerfully consider the enclosed materials, as well as what your fullest offering of time, talent, and treasure can look like.

There is also a special, new category on our pledge card inviting us all to participate in the "15 *Minute Giving Challenge.*" Giving Challenges are an opportunity to offer God more of our time, talent, and treasure. Our *first challenge* is a commitment to give God more time each Sunday by *arriving to Liturgy 15 minutes sooner* than we usually do. Or, if we cannot be present, we are challenged to set aside 15 minutes to pray on our own on Sunday morning. This amounts to an *additional hour* given to God each month. Imagine how He will bless and multiply that time!

Throughout the year we will have other similar challenges to help us give more of our time, talent, and treasure to the Lord.

We know that offering our Stewardship is an act of worship. Please consider joining us on Stewardship Sunday, November 10 as we collect and present our pledge cards to God at the end of the Divine Liturgy. Or, if you prefer, mail your pledge card to the Church office at your convenience.

God has done great and marvelous things through our Church. There is no limit to what He will do through us if all parts of the body participate!
